Dear Constituents,

Christmas is around the corner with all the joy that gifts, family, and faith brings. It has been an honour to serve as your Member of Parliament for this last year and a half. In this short time, I have sought to aggressively represent the interests of Fleetwood-Port Kells on issues that matter to you, like a tougher criminal justice system, lower taxes, better Lower Mainland infrastructure, choices in child care, an accountable health care system, democratic reform, and an elected senate where BC gets the seats she deserves!

This fall's sitting of the House of Commons has been an exciting time. The NDP finally served notice on Liberal corruption, joining with the Conservatives to insist that the Liberals are accountable to Canadians. At the time of this writing, the Liberals have stubbornly refused to agree to a compromise proposal for a February election to avoid a Christmas election. We will soon know the results of their stubbornness.

However, I pledge to continue to work for Fleetwood-Port Kells. The South Fraser Perimeter road project and other infrastructure projects are yet to be completed and the Liberals have yet to provide funding. Our roads, bridges, and borders need funding now, not more excuses!

I have also fought hard for a renewed and accountable health care system that actually delivers results, not phony Liberal promises. Don't get caught in the trap of Liberal spending announcements. Surrey Memorial Hospital still needs funding and our health care system is fast

NINA STANDS UP TO PROTECT CANADA'S CHILDREN: LIBERAL, NDP, AND BLOC VOTE TO DEFEAT RAISING THE AGE OF CONSENT

Earlier this year, Nina brought forward a motion (221) to change the age of consent from fourteen years to sixteen years of age.

The Liberals, NDP, and Bloc formed an alliance to vote against much needed protections for our children against child predators.

Nina commented on the vote afterward saying, “This Liberal government, with their NDP and Bloc allies, has chosen the supposed rights of predators over the safety of children. What is becoming increasingly clear is that the only way we will change the justice

system is by electing a Conservative government.”

Canada is fast becoming a haven for child predators who know that our age of consent laws are so weak and low, as to be completely unenforceable.

Nina Grewal remains committed to reintroducing her motion in the future, and hopes for better results under a new government. Commenting on the future, Ms Grewal said, “Canada's future generations of children deserve to be protected from predators. I will not stop until this weak Liberal law is changed.”

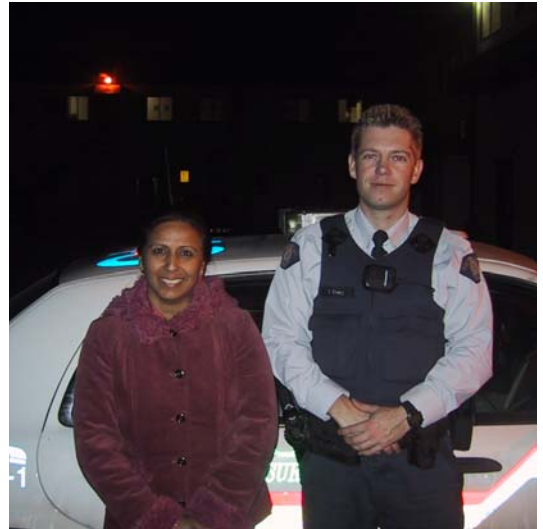

Nina's Standing Up For Safer Surrey Streets

Nina has consistently supported more funding for our colleges and universities, which are some of the lowest funded in the industrialized world thanks to Liberal cuts.

As well, Nina has pushed for more support for youth in the skilled trades. The skilled trades offer good income, an honest living, and sense of confidence. Canada is lacking skilled trades people, and in a booming area like Fleetwood-Port Kells, we need all the trades people we can get!



Nina's Standing Up For Surrey Seniors
